A Bipartisan Renewable Energy Target: The huge opportunities for Australia

The bipartisan deal on the Renewable Energy Target reached between the major parties last week will provide huge opportunities for renewable energy in Australia.

Most importantly, it will lock in no changes to the Small-scale Renewable Energy Scheme, which supports thousands of jobs in solar power and solar hot water.

Under the SRES, our sector stands to gain more than \$30 billion in investment between now and the end of the scheme. The legislation has been introduced into Parliament today and will be debated in the weeks ahead.
